ELIGIBILITY DEFINITIONS

GREEN HORSE/RIDER: Green refers to 1st year of showing in Open shows. An open show is one that does not restrict entries. This includes Open Schooling shows, but does not include shows put on for 4H or Pony Club ONLY for their members; nor does it include Walk/Trot or Leadline classes. As a special concession, the NVIHA allows entry in one Open Show in the previous show season before you must move on to the Novice and/or Open Divisions. Green Horse Over Fences is considered completely separate from Green Horse Hack.

NOVICE HORSE/RIDER (HACK): In order to qualify as a Novice Horse/Pony or Rider, you OR your horse cannot have won three (3) firsts prior to the 2009 show season in any Hack classes in an “Open” show (defined above). This excludes firsts in Green/Pony classes or Equitation classes. Eg. An experienced rider (has won 3 firsts) can enter a horse that has NOT won 3 firsts, and a novice rider (has NOT won 3 firsts) can ride an experienced horse.

OVER FENCES ELIGIBILITY:

Horses/ponies may enter a maximum of six over fences classes per day.

Jumper Riders: Riders may move up two levels and down one during the horseshow.

Pony Hunters & Jumpers – open to junior riders on ponies. In jumpers, riders may choose to jump either 2'6 or 2'9.

Short/Long Stirrup – For beginner riders. No cross-entry in other divisions.

2'6 Hunters – Open to all.

2'6 Jr/Amateur Hunters – Open to horse/rider combinations not to have shown 3'0.

3'0 Hunters – No cross entry with 2'6 hunters.

Ponies: Ponies are eligible where stated on the program. In jumper classes 3'3 and over separate combinations will not be set for the ponies.

SHOW INFORMATION

Helmets: Riders MUST wear helmets at all times on Show Grounds and fixed harnesses over fences. Juniors MUST wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets. Competitor number must be visible, and worn **at all times**.

Points: 1st – 7, 2nd – 5, 3rd – 4, 4th – 3, 5th – 2, 6th – 1

Minimum of 3 entries/class to qualify for ribbons/points/year end.

NVIHA YEAR END: Rider must have active NVIHA and HCBC membership to accumulate points. Hunter & Jumper Classes Count towards Yr-End.

Stabling: Stall \$20.00 per day/night
Paddock \$10.00 per day/night
Deposit \$25.00 (Refundable upon inspection)

Stabling is limited. Priority will be given to exhibitors who travel the furthest and who enter early. You MUST provide a clean stall deposit to receive your number.

Camping: \$10.00 per night \$15.00 with electrical hook-up

Ribbons: Rosettes for 1st and double flat to 6th.

Championships: Rosettes and prizes will be given to the champion and reserve champion of each division.

Age Groups: Senior 18 and over as of January 1, 2010
Junior A 15 – 17 as of January 1, 2010
Junior B 12 – 14 as of January 1, 2010
Junior C 11 and under as of January 1, 2010

Warm-up: The HUNTER & JUMPER RINGS will be open for hacking up to 15 minutes before the show starts.

All Jumper classes will be on the grass please shoe accordingly

Hunter and Jumper classes may be run as OPEN CARD. Please plan accordingly.

Non – Competitive Rounds permitted as per current EC rulebook, if time permits.

Hunter Divisions: Only the top 4 horses over fences will have their under saddle points count toward division championship. A 2nd rider is permitted in Hunter Under Saddle (Hunter Divisions Only) where competitor has multiple horses competing in same division. 2nd rider must qualify (eg. Jr/Am) and have applicable waivers signed. Make special notation on entry. # assigned to horse.

SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO COMBINE, ALTER, OR CANCEL ANY CLASS. Classes may be cancelled if insufficient entries on closing date.

QUESTIONS/CONCERNS SHOULD BE ADDRESSED TO OFFICIALS IN SHOWOFFICE. SHOW COMMITTEE HAS FINAL DECISION.

PROTESTS must be submitted to the show office in writing with a \$50.00 deposit (as per current HCBC rules).

JUDGE'S DECISION is final.
